

Washington Consumer Health Data Privacy Policy

Last Updated: August 1, 2026

This Washington Consumer Health Data Privacy Policy (“Policy”) is provided pursuant to the Washington My Health My Data Act and applies only to Washington residents.

This Policy governs the collection, use, and sharing of Consumer Health Data by Knight Health Holdings, LLC and its affiliated entities (“ScionHealth,” “we,” “us,” or “our”) through our websites and online services.

If there is any conflict between this Policy and another privacy notice or statement, this Policy controls with respect to Consumer Health Data subject to Washington law.

1. What Is Consumer Health Data?

“Consumer Health Data” means personal information that is linked or reasonably linkable to an individual and that identifies the individual’s past, present, or future physical or mental health status, including information from which health status may reasonably be inferred under Washington law.

This Policy does not apply to information that is excluded or exempt under the My Health My Data Act, including Protected Health Information (PHI) governed by HIPAA. Our collection, use and disclosure of PHI is covered by HIPAA and our Notice of Privacy Practices.

2. Categories of Consumer Health Data We Collect

Through our websites and online services, we may collect certain categories of Consumer Health Data, including:

- Information voluntarily submitted through requests or inquiries related to healthcare services
- Internet or online activity related to interactions with health-related content
- General location information (such as city or state) derived from IP address in connection with health-related webpages

Please do **not** submit sensitive information through our websites or when you contact us.

We do not intentionally collect:

- Social Security numbers
 - Financial account information
 - Biometric data
 - Precise location data
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3. Sources of Consumer Health Data

We may collect Consumer Health Data from:

- You, when you interact with our websites or submit information, including if you provide any information in an open text field in a form
 - Your devices or browser when you access health-related content
 - Service providers that support website operations and security
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4. Purposes for Collection and Use

Consumer Health Data is collected and used only to:

- Respond to healthcare-related inquiries or other requests made by you
 - Provide requested information about services
 - Operate, maintain, and improve our websites
 - Protect the security and integrity of our websites and systems
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5. Sharing of Consumer Health Data

We may share Consumer Health Data with:

- Service providers that support website hosting, analytics, and security
- ScionHealth-affiliated entities for internal operational and administrative purposes related to healthcare services
- Government authorities when required by law
- To other entities as necessary to facilitate a merger, sale, divestiture or change of control, or other similar transaction
- To other third parties with your consent or at your direction

We do not sell Consumer Health Data.

6. Consumer Rights

Washington residents have the right to:

- Confirm whether we collect, share or sell Consumer Health Data
 - Access Consumer Health Data, including, as applicable, a list of the third parties and affiliates to whom the information may have been sold or shared
 - Request deletion of Consumer Health Data
 - Withdraw consent for the sale or collection and sharing of Consumer Health Data, where applicable under Washington law
